REVISED OAKLAND UNIVERSITY MISSION STATEMENT A Recommendation

- 1. Division and Department: Academic Affairs
- 2. <u>Introduction:</u> The University has a long-standing commitment to strategic and mission-driven decision-making practices. Oakland University adopted a new Strategic Plan and identified three major goals: (1) Foster student success through a robust teaching and learning environment supported by comprehensive student services. (2) Be recognized as a strong research and scholarly environment focused on creative endeavors and on the discovery, dissemination and utilization of knowledge. (3) Become a leader in serving the needs and aspirations of our communities and region through expanded community relationships, institutional reputation and visibility, and engagement.

The University's mission statement is integral to our efforts to strategically manage the institution and an important tool in communicating our purpose to the external community. In addition Oakland University's regional accrediting body, the Higher Learning Commission of the North Central Association, requires the adoption of a university mission that: (1) is clear and articulated publicly; (2) guides the institution's operations; (3) reflects attention to human diversity; and (4) demonstrates commitment to the public good.

Consistent with the need to strategically manage the institution and meet the requirements of our regional accrediting body, it is recommended that the University's mission statement be revised. Attachments A and B are copies of the previously adopted mission statement and the proposed mission statement.

- 3. <u>Previous Board Action:</u> The Oakland University mission statement was adopted by the Board of Trustees on July 21, 1982, and amended on March 28, 2012 and March 6, 2015.

- 5. <u>Educational Implications:</u> The revised mission statement clearly states the University's commitment to the external and campus communities and encourage the consideration of all elements in the University's educational setting.
