What is your favorite part of being an OU Graduate student?

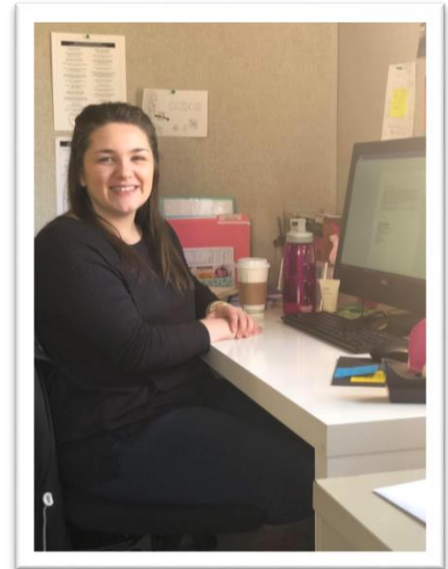
