- Students may transfer one-half of the credits (65cr) required for the baccalaureate degree. A minimum of 32 credits must be taken at OU.
- Students must have a minimum cumulative transfer GPA of 2.80 in order to be admitted to the pre-elementary education curriculum.
- A 2.5 "B-" is required for each course applied to the teaching major or teaching minor.
- One teaching major or two teaching minor endorsements are required as part of the Elementary Education degree. (See Elementary Education guides)
