AMENDMENTS TO AGREEMENT BETWEEN OAKLAND UNIVERSITY AND THE OAKLAND UNIVERSITY CHAPTER OF THE AMERICAN ASSOCIATION OF UNIVERSITY PROFESSORS A Recommendation

- Division and Department: Academic Affairs, Office of the Senior Vice President for Academic Affairs and Provost.
- 2. Introduction: On November 9, 2009, the Board of Trustees (Board) approved the Agreement between Oakland University and the Oakland University Chapter of the American Association of University Professors (Association), with the effective date of August 15, 2009 through August 14, 2012 (CBA). Subsequent to the Board's approval, and in connection with the implementation of the provisions that had been negotiated and modified in the CBA, it came to the attention of the parties that the CBA contained ministerial and clerical errors that did not reflect the true intent of the parties. One involved tuition waiver benefits that are not applicable to the Oakland University William Beaumont School of Medicine, and another involved the appointment of full-time co-principal investigators as well as full-time principle investigators in the category of Research and Full-Time Adjunct faculty.

To correct the ministerial and clerical errors, the parties entered into two amendments. See Attachments 1 and 2. The Amendments were ratified by the Association on November 8, 2010 by a vote of 252 in favor and 17 opposed. The Board has reserved for itself the authority to approve all collectively bargained contracts.

- 3. <u>Previous Board Action</u>: The Board has approved all previous collective bargaining agreements and amendments to collective bargaining agreements, including the CBA.

- **Personnel Implications:** Oakland will be able to appoint full-time co-principal investigators as well as full-time principle investigators in the category of Research and Full-Time Adjunct faculty.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties hereby amend the Agreement as follows

1. Appendix A.

Paragraph (1) of Appendix A – Research and Full-Time Adjunct Faculty is amended to replace the phrase "principal investigators" with the phrase "principal investigators" or co-principal investigators"

- 2. Ratification of the Agreement. The provisions contained in this LOA supersede and replace, where applicable, any and all inconsistent terms and provisions contained in the agreement whether or not specifically identified or referenced herein. All terms and provisions of the Agreement that are not effectively amended by this LOA are hereby ratified.
- 3. <u>Effective Date.</u> This LOA is effective upon satisfaction of any and all required Oakland and Association approval and/or ratification processes
