Graduate Certificate in Oncology Rehabilitation

Program delivery

All courses requirements for the Graduate Certificate in Oncology Rehabilitation program are 100% online. Students admitted and enrolled in this online graduate certificate program qualify for in-state tuition.

Non-US citizens applying for admissions to the Graduate Certificate in Oncology Rehabilitation program do **not** require a visa. Therefore, the Non-US Citizen Information section of the graduate application (Checklist item 7 of 9) does not need to be completed.

Program application requirements

Proof of physical therapy licensure, registration, certificate (or the equivalent) in their country of residence

Admission terms and application deadlines

Applicants are admitted Fall, Winter and Summer semesters. Before an applicant's file can be reviewed for full program admission, all application documents must be received in Graduate Study and Lifelong Learning by the semester deadlines listed below. Incomplete applications will not be sent to departments for admission review.

August 1	fall semester
November 16	winter semester
April 1	summer semester

Graduate certificate requirements

To fulfill the certificate requirements, the student must complete 17 credits in an approved program of study.

Course requirements (17 credits)

- PT 672—PT Management of Blood, Head and Neck, and Central Nervous System Oncology Conditions (3 Cr)

- PT 598—Independent Study (1-4 Cr)
- PT 615—Research Directed Study (1-4 Cr)

Policy Updates

International applicants to distance learning programs delivered 100% online

An international applicant is anyone who is not a US citizen at the time of application to Oakland University.

Non-US citizens applying for admissions to a distance learning program that does NOT require any on-campus instruction at Oakland University (**100% Online**) do **not** require a non-immigrant visa. Therefore, the Non-US Citizen Information section of the graduate application (Checklist item 7 of 9) does not need to be completed.

Non-US citizens, including those applying for admissions to a distance learning program that requires on-campus instruction at Oakland University (**50-99% Online**) **do require** a non-immigrant visa. These applicants **must** complete the Non-US Citizen Information section of the graduate application (Checklist item 7 of 9).

International application deadlines

International applications are reviewed for fall and winter admission only. To ensure adequate time for review, international applications must be completed at least six months before the desired date of intended enrollment in the University. All international application materials must be submitted by May 1 for fall admission and by September 1 for winter admission. International applicants are not eligible for Special Graduate classification.

Non-US citizens applying for admissions to a distance learning program that does **NOT** require any on-campus instruction at Oakland University (**100% Online**) are not subject to international application deadlines. Applicants should follow the published application deadlines for the distance learning program of interest.
