

**Permission For Undergraduate To Enroll In A Graduate Course**

Upper-division undergraduates with appropriate credentials and permission may enroll in 500-level graduate courses and use them toward their baccalaureate degrees. The student must receive the consent of their academic advisor and the department offering the course. Courses completed for graduate credit and used to satisfy baccalaureate degree requirements may not also be used in the future to fulfill the requirements of a graduate degree.

An undergraduate student enrolled in a graduate course is subject to all university regulations affecting undergraduates. The university, by allowing a student to earn graduate credit while still an undergraduate, makes no guarantee of the student's admissibility to any graduate program.
