



Mike Brennan is an accomplished executive and entrepreneur, with 28 years of experience involving both growth and start-up organizations. He spent the first 15 years of his career with Precision Color Inc., both as Plant Manager and in direct sales. In November of 2011, Mike joined the Macomb-OU INCubator to lead capital strategy efforts on behalf of incubator clients. As of August 2014, the incubator has lead the State in Small Business Development Center SmartZone grant funding and has also helped to secure more than \$12M privately while creating over 200 jobs during that period. Overall, Mike has helped private emerging companies to secure more than \$150M while supporting the creation of greater than 1,000 new jobs in his career. Mike's community involvement includes pro bono advisory for emerging technology companies, entrepreneurs, and private charitable foundations, as well as youth coaching.
