- 1. Complete Associate Degree in Graphic Design at OCC.
- 2. Completion of the Associate Degree in Graphic Design will secure the following benefits towards the Graphic Design bachelor degree
  - a. ART 1002 will be satisfied
  - b. ART 1004 will be satisfied
  - c. ART 2100 will be satisfied
  - d. DES 1130 will be satisfied
  - e. DES 2230 will be satisfied
- The associate degree is 65 credits; however, it is highly recommended to complete OU's General Education requirements before transferring. This can be completed through OU's General Education categories or the Michigan Transfer Agreement (MTA). If pursuing the MTA, ENG 1520 must be taken as this is a pre-req for upper level writing courses.
- 4. Remaining coursework at OU:
  - a. Semester 1: DES 3350, DES 3330, DES 3340, AH 1002
  - b. Semester 2: DES Elective, DES 3360, DES 4430, AH 3530
  - c. Semester 3: DES Elective, AH Elective (AH 3110, 3120 or 3130 suggested), DES 4999
- 5. Total of 124 credit hours is needed to graduate.
