See WCC program for required courses. Recommended courses not completed at WCC must be completed at OU.

- 3. At Oakland complete one of the majors listed below:
  - a. Accounting (24 ch): ACC 4001, 4002, 4180, 4003 + 4 (4000 level) ACC elective courses
  - b. Economics (21 ch): ECN 3020, 3040, 4050 + 4 (3000 or 4000 level) ECN elective courses
  - c. Finance (21 ch): ACC 3010, FIN 3600, 3680, 3720 + 3 (3000 or 4000 level) FIN elective courses or choose the Wealth Management Specialization of seven courses
  - d. General Management (15 ch): ORG 4310 + 11 credits of (3000 or 4000 level) electives chosen with an academic adviser to best maximize a student's interests. Six credits must be at the 4000 level
  - e. HR Management (18-20 ch): ORG 4300, 4340, 4600 + 2 (3000 or 4000 level) ORG elective courses
  - f. Management Information Systems (21 ch): MIS 3050, 3140, 4050, 4060 + 3 (3000 or 4000 level) MIS elective courses or choose one of two prescribed specializations
  - g. Marketing (21 ch): MKT 4040, 4050, 4530 + 3 (3000 or 4000 level) MKT elective courses
  - h. Operations Management (18-19 ch): Six (3000 or 4000 level) elective courses or choose one of three prescribed specializations of six courses
- 4. ACHIEVE is a career and professional development program designed to help students transition to full-time employment after graduation. Students will complete three zero credit courses at Oakland University.

## Notes:

- Once at Oakland University it is best to meet with an Academic Adviser to develop an individualized plan for completing the bachelor degree.
- Additional credits required for OU degree are 45-54 depending on which major is chosen.
- Previous iterations of the AABATR can be used as well. The recently discontinued Associate of Arts in Business (AABAS) will be recognized as well.
- The Business Actuarial Science B.S. does not apply to this agreement due to the different course requirements from the other business majors.
- Students majoring in Economics, BS can also take MTH 191. All other business programs (Finance, General Management, Human Resource Management, Management Information Systems, Marketing, and Operations Management only require up to MTH 180 or MTH 176.
