OAKLAND COUNTY IT / CLEMIS AGREEMENT A Recommendation

- 1. <u>Division and Department:</u> Finance and Operations, Police Department
- 2. <u>Introduction:</u> The Oakland University Police Department (OUPD) is an active member of the Court and Law Enforcement Management Information System (CLEMIS), an information management system comprised of specific software applications operated and maintained by the CLEMIS Division of Oakland County for law enforcement purposes.

The CLEMIS Division requires that an annually updated, signed agreement between all police agencies and CLEMIS be maintained in the County database. Prior to 2016, the Vice President for Finance and Administration had authorization to sign this agreement.

Beginning in 2016, CLEMIS requires the approval and signature of the governing board having authority over the local police agency. Upon Board approval, the OUPD will file a copy of the IT/CLEMIS Agreement with Oakland County along with a copy of the minutes from the Board meeting authorizing the appropriate signatures.

- **4.** <u>Budget Implications:</u> All cost associated with the CLEMIS agreement continue to be funded through the OUPD operating budget. There are no incremental costs.

RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees authorizes the Chief Operating Officer to execute the IT / CLEMIS Agreement with Oakland County for law enforcement purposes; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees authorizes the President, the Chief Operating Officer, and their respective designees, to perform all acts and deeds and to execute and deliver all contracts, instruments and documents required by this resolution that are necessary, expedient and proper in connection with the IT / CLEMIS Agreement and the ongoing administration of the IT / CLEMIS software; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that said contracts, instruments and documents shall be reviewed by and be in a form acceptable to the Vice President for Legal Affairs and General Counsel prior to execution, and be in compliance with the law and with University policies and regulations and conform to the legal standards of the Vice President for Legal Affairs and General Counsel.
