APPROVAL OF HONORARY DEGREE FOR KENNETH JANKE A Recommendation

- **1.** <u>Division and Department</u>: Academic Affairs, Office of the Senior Vice President for Academic Affairs and Provost.
- 2. <u>Introduction</u>: In accordance with Article IX of the Bylaws of the Board of Trustees, honorary degrees may be awarded by the Board of Trustees in recognition of distinguished accomplishment and service within the scope of the arts and letters, sciences, professions, and public service as recognized and supported by the University. The awarding of honorary degrees reaffirms Oakland University's scholarly, creative, and humanitarian values and ties the University to the community at large.

Kenneth Janke joined Aflac in 1985 as Manager of Investment Relations. He has served as Senior Vice President, Executive Vice President, Chief Financial Officer, and President of Aflac U.S. He also chaired Aflac's Corporate Disclosure Committee. Throughout his 30-year career at Aflac, his contributions to the company were noted and led to increasingly more responsibility. His work was also recognized externally. In 2002, Investor Relations magazine named the Investor Relations department the Best Overall Investor Relations Department for a large-cap company and in 2003 Janke himself was recognized by the same magazine as the Best Investor Relations Officer for a large-cap company. Prior to joining Aflac, Janke served as Director of Corporate Services for the National Association of Investors Corporation.

The Honorary Degree Committee recommends Mr. Janke for his record of outstanding achievement in business, his contributions to Oakland University's School of Business Administration and his philanthropy that have led to humankinds commercial, social and civic betterment.

- His leadership of a company that values diversity and development of its top talent. During his time at Aflac the company was recognized three times as a Top 50 Employers for Minorities and Working Mothers and was also recognized in Working Mothers magazine for one of 100 Best Companies for working mothers
- His progressive leadership opportunities within a single company indicating his contributions across numerous roles
- He is credited with playing a large role in the growth and success of Aflac, a company that now covers more than 50 million people world wide
- His recognized commitment to transparency and communication that allow investors to make better investment decisions
- His successful leadership of the Investor Relations Department at Aflac that was recognized as the Best Overall Investor Relations Department for a Large-cap company
