# APPROVAL OF REVISED SCHEMATIC DESIGN FOR DODGE HALL LABORATORY RENOVATION

#### A Recommendation

- **1.** <u>Division and Department</u>: Academic Affairs Division, Operations & Finance, and Facilities Management Department.
- 2. <u>Introduction</u>: In an effort to align with the University's strategic goal of a strong research and scholarly environment, underutilized space in Dodge Hall (DH) was reviewed with Academic Affairs and the decision made to create needed laboratories and associated offices in the Dodge Hall Renovations project (Project). A Request For Proposal (RFP) was released for comprehensive Architectural and Engineering (A&E) services to develop state-of-the-art laboratories with associated offices in the building. In November 2018, Constantine George Pappas AIA Architecture and Planning was selected to design this Project at a cost of \$192,800. At the June 10, 2019 Board of Trustees meeting, a Bond proposal was approved that includes a \$3,000,000 allocation for the renovation of critical academic spaces in DH.

The scope of the Project that was submitted on August 12, 2019 included the renovation of only the first floor, east wing of the building. As design and scope were developed, the design was optimized to simplify the first-floor design and add spaces on the third floor. This modified renovation plan will include the alteration and renovation of academic spaces in DH to include laboratory and associated office spaces for the College of Arts and Sciences.

- 3. <u>Previous Board Action</u>: At the June 10, 2019 Board of Trustees meeting, a Bond proposal was approved. At the August 12, 2019 Board of Trustees meeting, the schematic design for a project to renovate only the first floor, east wing of the building was approved.
- **4.** <u>Budget Implications</u>: The funding source for this \$3,000,000 project is the 2019 Bonds.
- **5.** Educational Implications: The creation of laboratory spaces and renovation of associated office spaces will provide students with state-of-the-art facilities in which to learn. The Project will provide state-of-the-art layout and equipment that will improve accessibility for students and departmental efficiency, all of which contribute to the University's strategic goal of student success.

- 7. <u>University Reviews/Approvals</u>: This recommendation was formulated by the Associate Vice President for Facilities Management and reviewed by the Provost's Office, Vice President for Finance and Administration, Chief Operating Officer, and President.

#### 8. Recommendation:

RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees approves the Dodge Hall Renovation Project. The total project cost will not exceed \$3,000,000. All construction costs, consultant fees (including the Constantine George Pappas fee of \$192,800), permits, low voltage, movable furniture, fixtures and other equipment, moving costs, and other owner related soft costs are also included; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees approves the Dodge Hall Laboratory Renovation Schematic Design (Attachment A, as may be immaterially amended during continuing design and construction phases of the project); and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees authorizes the President, Chief Operating Officer, and their respective designees, to perform all acts and deeds and to execute and deliver all contracts, instruments, and documents required by this resolution that are necessary, expedient, and proper in connection with the Dodge Hall Renovation Project and the ongoing administration; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that said contracts, instruments and documents shall be reviewed by and be in a form acceptable to the Vice President for Legal Affairs and General Counsel prior to execution, and be in compliance with the law and with University policies and regulations and conform to the legal standards of the Vice President for Legal Affairs and General Counsel.


