## Minutes of the Formal Session of the Oakland University Board of Trustees December 7, 2020

#### A. Call to Order

Chair Tonya Allen called the meeting to order at 2:01 p.m. via Zoom.

#### B. Roll Call

Mr. Victor A. Zambardi, Vice President for Legal Affairs, General Counsel and Secretary to the Board of Trustees, conducted a roll call and all of the Board members were present.

### C. President's Report

President Pescovitz presented an update on Oakland University's COVID-19 response. Contingency plans remain in place and Oakland University continues to evaluate county and state mandates related to COVID-19. Face Masks, social distancing, and hand washing are all required

practices to limit COVID-19 infections and reduce virus spread. Online Daily Health Assessments are required for any individual visiting campus.

Based upon an increase in positive COVID-19 cases by the week of November 7, 2020 and prior to Governor's Executive Order, the University decided to switch Fall 2020 classes to remote learning.

BioButtons are now available to students, faculty, and staff. Oakland University is the first university in the U.S. to utilize this wearable screening device.

Oakland University State of the University Address was conducted virtually on October 29, 2020, and covered topics including Fall 2020 enrollment, employee recognition programs, Strive for 45 campaign, Reimagining OU initiative, and introduction of new University leadership and new Trustees Trina Scott and Reverend Joe Jones.

Fall 2020 Commencement will be conducted virtually and feature video messages from Oakland University leadership. Schools and Colleges will host individual graduation celebrations. The pre-recorded event will be broadcast on the Oakland University YouTube channel starting at 10 a.m. on Saturday, December 19, 2020.

President Pescovitz introduced Oakland University Political Science Professors, Dr. David Dulio and Dr. John Klemanski. Drs. Dulio and Klemanski, recent speakers at the 2020 President's Colloquium, provided an analysis of Michigan's role in the 2020 election.

Trustee Calley inquired as to the number of BioButtons distributed to date. Mr. Glenn McIntosh, Senior Vice President for Student Affairs and Chief Diversity Officer, stated that over 500 BioButtons had been distributed as of December 7, 2020.

Dean Duane Mezwa and Dr. Jason Wasserman provided an update on the Oakland University William Beaumont School of Medicine Medical Humanities and Clinical Bioethics program. Dean Mezwa presented an overview of current Medical Humanities and Clinical Bioethics curriculum, and noted that Oakland University William Beaumont School of Medicine remains deeply committed to training well rounded physicians who will be patient centered, humanistic, and engaged in their communities. Medical Humanities and Clinical Bioethics curriculum represents a set of six longitudinal courses that span the first three years of the medical program and entail more than 75 contact hours.

Dr. Wasserman presented a new Medical Humanities and Clinical Bioethics initiative. Oakland University William Beaumont School of Medicine curriculum is unparalleled in its commitment to humanism and medicine, and current curriculum includes a seven-week seminar led by Rabbi Herb Yoskowitz that specifically focuses on the Holocaust and Nazi medicine. The new initiative extends this effort to include a mentored overseas excursion to Auschwitz Birkenau. The 15 students who participate in the program will, upon return, develop educational materials and disseminate them throughout the local community, into schools and other organizations in an effort to push back against the atrophying knowledge of the Holocaust. This will involve collaborations with the CIS Maisal Center for Judaic Studies and Community Engagement and the Holocaust Memorial Center in Southfield.

Mr. Mike Westfall, Vice President for University Advancement, reported on fundraising efforts to support this initiative. President Pescovitz created the Bella Rozencweig Hirsch Endowment for Biomedical Ethics, an endowment to support the program's vision and honor her mother. The overall endowment goal is one million dollars. Two engagement salons were held in October and November. \$150,000 has been confirmed, with 10 active gift conversations ongoing.

President Pescovitz thanked Jo Hairston, Executive Associate to the President, for her dedicated 32 years of service to Oakland University in light of her retirement, and a holiday video was presented.

RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees authorizes the President and the Vice President for Finance and Administration, and their respective designees, to perform all acts and deeds and to execute and deliver all contracts, instruments, and documents required by this resolution that are necessary, expedient and proper in connection with the Varner Hall Renovation and Expansion Project; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that said contracts, instruments, and documents shall be reviewed by and be in a form acceptable to the Vice President for Legal Affairs and General Counsel prior to execution, and be in compliance with the law and with University policies and regulations and conform to the legal standards of the Vice President for Legal Affairs and General Counsel.

Mr. Beaghan requested Board approval of the \$45 million project budget and approval of the schematics for the renovation and expansion of Varner Hall. To date, the Board has approved the bond at the August 2019 Board meeting, and after a competitive bid process at the August 2020 Board meeting, the Board approved the hiring of Stantec as the architect engineer firm and Granger as the construction manager for the project.

Dr. C. Michelle Piskulich, Interim Executive Vice President for Academic Affairs and Provost, advised that Varner Hall houses the College of Arts and Sciences, the School of Music, Theatre and Dance, the departments of Political Science, History and Sociology, Anthropology, Social Work and Criminal Justice, the Classroom Support Unit, and offices, practice spaces, classrooms, a TV studio, and two performance spaces for the School of Music, Theatre and Dance. Mr. Michael Decoster, architect and principal from Stantec, provided a detailed walkthrough of the Varner Hall project scope.

Trustee Scott noted that as Oakland University continues to build out opportunities with suppliers that it considers diverse suppliers and local vendors, and Chair suggested obtaining an update on Oakland University's vendor selection process from the Office of Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion.

After discussion, Trustee Tull, seconded by Trustee Stolicker, moved approval of the recommendation, and the motion was unanimously approved by those present.
