Once admitted into the Social Work Program students must maintain a 2.8 overall and a 3.0 within the major consisting of the following courses (SOC 2010, SOC 2020, SW 3101, SW 3102, SW 3201, SW 3203, SW 3302/SOC 3220, SW 4103, SW 4970 and SW 4971).
