Students may transfer an unlimited amount of credit from Delta, and must complete a minimum of 45 credit hours from OU to meet degree requirements. As programs may limit how much transfer credit can be used toward requirements, <u>it is</u> <u>highly recommended that students work with both an OU academic adviser and their Delta academic adviser to</u> <u>maximize the applicability of coursework to specific requirements</u>.

Students must have a minimum cumulative transfer GPA of 2.5 in order to be admitted to the Wellness and Health Promotion curriculum.

OU's Wellness and Health Promotion program is ranked within the top 10 programs in the country, and is accredited with the National Wellness Institute.

Earn a Master of Public Health (MPH) in addition to a bachelor's degree with the WHP to Public Health 4 + 1 program!

Oakland University will always honor the **MACRAO transfer agreement** and apply it to the General Education requirement the same as MTA.
