### MAJOR REQUIREMENTS

Students may transfer an unlimited amount of credit from Mott, and must complete a minimum of 45 credit hours from OU to meet degree requirements. As programs may limit the transfer credits that can be used toward requirements, <u>it is</u> <u>highly recommended that students work with both an OU (school/college) academic adviser and their Mott</u> <u>counselor to maximize the applicability of coursework to specific requirements.</u>

### TRANSFERRING WITH THE MICHIGAN TRANSFER AGREEMENT (MTA):

When choosing to complete MTA to satisfy General Education, please confirm the best courses to take to fulfill the agreement with your academic adviser at Mott or at the <u>Mott MTA Approved Courses</u> website. Completing MTA when following this major guide will satisfy OU's transferrable General Education requirements.

### **EXPLORATORY REQUIREMENT:**

Students with majors in the College of Arts and Sciences (CAS) must satisfy an exploratory requirement. This can be done by completing a double major or a CAS minor or concentration; or by completing a minimum of 12 credits in a single CAS rubric, outside of their major rubric. Please confirm transfer course choices with an OU CAS adviser. *Students using MTA or MACRAO must complete the exploratory requirement at Oakland University or another four-year institution.* 



### NOTES:

Oakland University will always honor the **MACRAO transfer agreement** and apply it to the General Education requirement the same as MTA.

The College of Arts and Sciences requires that a minimum of 16 credits in the major be completed at Oakland University.
