A minimum of 16 credits in the major must be completed at OU. Therefore, before planning to complete all the requirements detailed in this transfer guide, it is recommended that you consult with an OU adviser for more individualized course-planning assistance.

Students may transfer an unlimited amount of credit from Wayne, and must complete a minimum of 45 credit hours from OU to meet degree requirements. As programs may limit the transfer credits that can be used toward requirements, it is highly recommended that students work with both an OU (school/college) academic adviser and their Wayne counselor to maximize the applicability of coursework to specific requirements.

EXPLORATORY REQUIREMENT:

Students with majors in the College of Arts and Sciences (CAS) must satisfy an exploratory requirement. This can be done by completing a double major or a CAS minor or concentration; or by completing a minimum of 12 credits in a single CAS rubric, outside of their major rubric. Students using MTA or MACRAO must complete the exploratory requirement at Oakland University or another four-year institution.





NOTES:

Oakland University will always honor the **MACRAO transfer agreement** and apply it to the General Education requirement the same as MTA.

The College of Arts and Sciences requires that a minimum of 16 credits in the major be completed at Oakland University.
